

The CCI Board of Trustees would like to inform you of a change to the format in which examination results (overall scores) are reported to you as a potential Candidate taking a CCI administered examination.

CCI will begin reporting examination results using a format commonly known as “scaled scoring”. Scores will be reported on a scale ranging from 0 to 900. A minimum passing score of 650 will be used for all examinations. Currently CCI uses a standard scoring model based on a scale of 0 to 100, with a minimum passing score of 69.33 to 73% (depending on the examination and form of the examination a Candidate receives.)

- Cardiographic Technician Examination: March 1, 2008
- Cardiovascular Science Examination: April 1, 2008
- Electrophysiology Registry Examination: November 1, 2008
- Invasive Registry Examination: April 1, 2008
- Non-Invasive/Echocardiography Examination: March 1, 2008
- Vascular Registry Examination: March 1, 2008
