



POLICY 43 – STUDENTS TESTING PRE-GRADUATION

I. GENERAL

CCI will approve applicants who are students of cardiovascular education programs to test prior to graduation upon meeting requirements set by the Program Director of the educational institution.

II. EARNING THE CREDENTIAL

The applicant (student) will not earn the CCI credential, even if they pass the CCI examination, until the CCI office has received confirmation, by form of student verification letter or graduation certificate, from the educational program OR received the required documentation to qualify under another current CCI examination qualification for the specific examination

It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide proof of graduation and/or other required documentation.

III. DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

The Program Director must state in the Student Verification Letter when the applicant is expected to graduate and IF there is any limitation requested by the Program Director as to the first date the applicant should be allowed to take the examination.
